

Correspondence Lessons

A scholarship program for those who have attended an overnight week of elementary or middle school camp.



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Do your lesson as soon as you can so you can stay up-to-date. If you lose a lesson, you can download one from www.campgrace.us or send \$1 with a note asking for another one.
2. **Pray first**, asking the Lord to help you as you study His Word.
3. Put your first and last name and complete mailing address on the answer sheet.
4. **Read and study** the lesson several times. Most of the answers are in the lesson. Complete the lesson using the answer sheet provided. **Keep your lessons** in a safe place for future reference.
5. The lessons are worded in the King James Version unless otherwise noted. If you do not have a King James Version of the Bible, you can look up passages on the Internet at www.biblegateway.com
6. Put your answer sheet in an envelope to protect it from getting torn and mail it to:

PROGRAM RULES

1. Our grading system is as follows: A= 2 mistakes or less, B= 3-4 mistakes, C= 5-6 mistakes, D= 7-8 mistakes, F= 9 or more mistakes. D and F graded lessons do not count toward a scholarship and will be returned for you to redo.
2. Put your first and last name— the name we know you by— on each answer sheet that you send in. If your name is not on the lesson, you will not receive credit for it. If you have a popular name, please also use your middle initial.
3. You **must have at least one lesson returned to us by October 31st** in order to continue in the program. If you do not send any lessons back by October 31st, we will not continue to send you lessons and you will not be eligible for an earned scholarship this year.
4. **The set of lessons must be satisfactorily completed and postmarked by April 20th for you to earn the \$75 scholarship.** If you do not complete your lessons this year but you do come to camp, you will be eligible to begin the lessons again. If you do not complete your lessons this year and also do not come to camp, you are not eligible for lessons the next year.
5. At the end of the year, you will receive an **Honor Roll trophy** if you sent ALL of your lessons in on time (by the 20th of the month the lesson was issued) and received all A's. You will receive **a ribbon** if one or more lessons were not received on time but you received all A's. We use the postmark date or the actual date hand-delivered to our office. Be advised that due to the nature of our ministry, there is not always someone in the office; and **any lesson handed to a staff member outside of the office will not qualify for the Honor Roll.**
6. If you are not able to attend Camp Grace the following summer, your earned scholarship may be used the next time you come to summer camp.
7. Earned scholarships are NOT transferable to another child and may ONLY be used toward the payment for a week of overnight summer camp.
